

Hodges Taylor Gallery is Moving

The inaugural exhibitions, in the new space will be works of artists making their solo debut with the gallery, Beverly Buchanan and Valentina DuBasky. These two artists create bold, powerful images, one in sculpture and works on paper and the other in paint on paper. The exhibits continue through Oct.

Valentina DuBasky's work presents her interpretation of cave paintings, rendering the totemic anima figures with an expressionistic treatment. Working on both paper and canvas, DuBasky's surfaces are lushly painted. ART-News said of DuBasky, " a painter who belongs to the magical wing of today's young artists... (she has) a poetical vision."

DuBasky has exhibited internationally in group shows including Documenta 34 Raumes, in Berlin, Germany as well as Arts in Embassies, Oslo, Norway. Her work was also included in the Women in Print exhibition at the National Museum for Women in the Arts, Washington, D.C. and the Albright Knox Museum in Buffalo. Solo exhibitions include Oscarsson-Hood and Ruth Siegel Galleries in New York City, van Stratten in Chicago and Rena Haveson Gallery in Pittsburgh.
